## From Your President...

Hello Everyone!

It's kind of nice to be stranded here at home for the day! One of the perks of being a teacher is snow days! I love those 5:30 a.m. phone calls where, after hearing school is closed for the day, I can roll over and turn off my alarm. Therefore, I have no excuse not to get this letter done today!

I haven't written a newsletter since before our annual banquet. It was a wonderful evening! We enjoyed celebrating the many accomplishments of our club members and had a heartwarming and informative talk from our guest speakers from Salem Children's Home. We collected a significant amount of horse supplies, as well as donating our profit from the silent auction, to the home's equine program. I would like to thank John Simpson for organizing the banquet, and Kris Boente for arranging our speakers. I especially want to thank Marilyn Weber for keeping track of all the participants in the High Point program, as well as getting all the awards. What a huge job! The amazing thing about this is that Marilyn knew what she was getting into when agreeing to handle High Point again! Margaret Moore came through with lovely decorations that really spiffed the place up. It's nice to have a wedding planner in the group! I'm thankful everyone who came arrived home safely. It was such a foggy night!

I went to the Region XI meeting last weekend in Quincy and have a few things I would like to share with all of you. A significant amount of the meeting involved discussing the Region XI budget for 2010. Like every other organization in the U.S., Region XI is beginning to have to use its reserves to keep the organization going. The show last year did not make enough to pay for the expenses of the region. The budget committee is cutting back wherever they can for 2010. Cut backs include reducing the amount they were giving in scholarships, taking out the money earmarked for Horse Fair, reducing the per diem amount for volunteers at the Region XI show in July, as well as making a few of the paid jobs during the show into volunteer jobs. One of the biggest expenses of the region is the awards given during the regional show. Many of these issues affect us as a club directly because we, along with the Illinois club, host the Sport Horse Regionals during our June show. After hearing where the region is financially, I feel that we really need to push sponsorships of our regional classes. It costs \$75 to sponsor a regional class. I would think, as a group, we could find enough sponsors to cover most of the Sport Horse regional classes. Another topic that was discussed is the adding of Select Rider classes to our July Region XI show and subsequently to our National show in October. A select rider is defined as anyone who has not received a Top 5 in the division they are competing in. Hopefully, this will encourage greater participation by newcomers by giving them a class where the playing field is a little more equal. It was also announced that adult showmanship and adult equitation classes have been added to the National show list, which means if an interest is shown, those classes could potentially be added to the National show. Another topic that was discussed involved encouraging each region to host a regional trail ride. I would love to participate, so I'm hoping some club in the region will find this idea intriguing and run with it.

Show season is right around the corner. MAHA will be held the first weekend in March. Good luck to all those who are participating! Springfest dates are April 1-4th. Our workday is Friday, April 2nd this year. As usual, we need all the help we can get. If you will be showing that weekend, please volunteer a few hours of your time. Also, look in this newsletter for information about the dressage clinic coming up the third weekend in March.

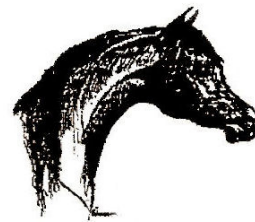

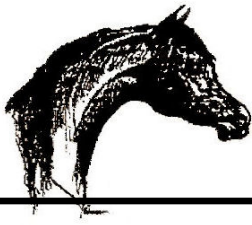
