A two ride or a three ride rule per horse may be invoked depending on the number of entries. A maximum number of rides per arena per day will be imposed. Post-entries will not be accepted after May 11, 2010, except to fill scratches. All classes will run simultaneously with other sessions and are open to Arabians and Half-Arabians. Copies of ride times will be available at the Show Office. A horse may show in no more than two consecutive levels, from Training Level through Grand Prix.

However, only awards made to the top 50% of the class (rounded up and not to exceed 5 awards) will receive Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes payout, AHA Horse Achievement Award, Amateur Achievement Awards, High Point Horse Achievement Award, High Point Amateur Achievement Award and Distance Award Points." Refer to AHA Article. 1220.2.

RULES FOR REGIONAL CLASSES

1. DRESSAGE CLASS REQUIREMENTS:

Refer to AHA Art. 1432 for Reg. qualification requirements and Art. 1109.2 for the AHA/USDF All-Breeds Awards requirements. It is the responsibility of the person signing the entry form to verify the horse being entered and shown is eligible. There is no minimum number of horses required to fill a class. No horse may compete in more than 2 consecutive levels, excluding Introductory, at a specific show. Riders must be appropriately attired in accordance with USEF and AHA rules. This competition is to be conducted in accordance with AHA and USEF rules. A caller may be used if provided by competitor. WHIPS ARE PROHIBITED. Refer to AHA Art. 1125 for scoring procedures.

2. DRESSAGE ENTRIES: All entries close 4/27/10. Post entries will not be accepted after 5/11/10 except for horses qualifying for the FIRST TIME after 4/27/10 and to fill scratches. Horses qualifying at the Illinois/ARAB Inc. show for the FIRST TIME have until 1 hour after the last class is concluded to enter the regional show. Ride times will be posted in show office approx. 3 hours after entries close.

3. FOOTING: Dressage classes will be held in the outdoor arena under cover and on sand. Hunter/Jumper classes will be held in the Coliseum.

4. JUDGING: Classes will be judged using the Single-Judge system.

5. HUNTER/JUMPER ENTRIES: Entries close 4/27/10. Post entries will be accepted until 8:00 PM 6/3/10. Exception: horses qualifying for the first time after 4/27/10.

6. HUNTER/JUMPER REQUIREMENTS: It is the responsibility of the person signing the entry form that the horse is eligible to be entered and shown. Refer to AHA Art. 1214 and 1215 for Reg. Working Hunter/Jumper qualifications.

7. HUNTER/JUMPER SCORING: Refer to AHA Art. 1125 and 1126.

8. SPORT HORSE QUALIFICATIONS: refer to AHA Article 1731. Horse must be qualified at an AHA Recognized show/division for the Regional Championship class(es) entered. Entries will be accepted until 2 pm on 6/3/10.

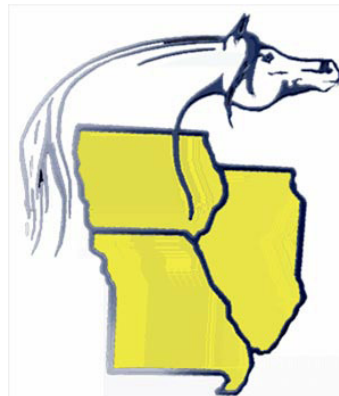
9. SPORT HORSE IN-HAND classes will use the triangle pattern. Refer to USEF AR 153 through AR 157 in the USEF Rule Book.

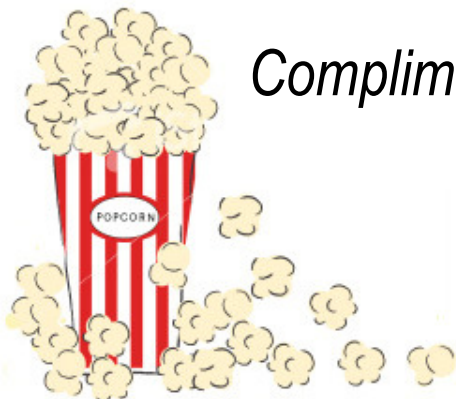

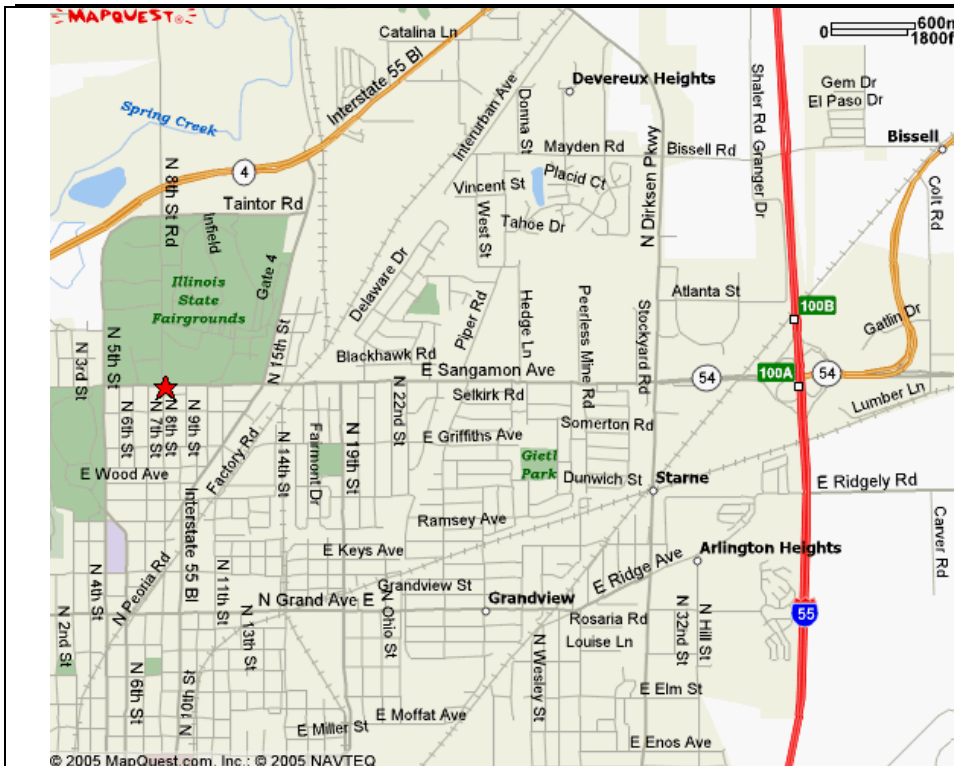

GENERAL RULES & REQUIREMENTS

ALL PRIZE MONEY MUST BE PICKED UP AT SHOW – NO CHECKS MAILED

This horse show is conducted in accordance with the Rules of the USEF and Arabian Horse Association. The official rulebook of each organization will prevail for this show. Each participant in this show is responsible for knowledge of these rules and is subject to these rules. Any changes or corrections of the rules will automatically become part of this prize list. Questions that may arise that are not covered by either AHA or USEF rulebooks will be decided by the Show Committee and their decisions will be final.

PAYBACKS: Checks available at Barn Office 1 hour after close of session in which class was held. Placings required to show back in championships must enter Championship classes before prize money will be received. Efforts made to verify wins for last session within 1/2 hour of each class to facilitate checking out. Authorized signature required to pick up check. ILLINOIS/ARAB, INC. ALL ARABIAN HORSE SHOW not responsible for payment of prize money 60 days after issuance. Please cash checks promptly.

USEF MEMBERSHIP: Life, Senior active & junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at regular competitions, eventing competitions at the preliminary level or above and combined driving competitions at the advanced level, dressage and vaulting competitions and endurance rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent or trainer at regular competitions, eventing competitions, dressage competitions and combined driving competitions upon payment of a \$30 non-member registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule: 1) lead-line; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk/trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, Pas De Deux and Quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorses Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USAE beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport horse Breeding classes.

USEF RULES: Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book, will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. See USEF Rule Book for Arabian Horse rules, class descriptions and judging specifications. Any changes in the USEF rules will automatically become part of this Prize list. The Show Committee reserves the right to make such changes in procedure, personnel, rules and regulations as deemed by them to be in the best interest of the show.

ADMISSION TO ARENA: No person is permitted to enter arena except judges, assistants, exhibitors in class & show photographer. Headers are not permitted in arena until summoned by order of Judge.

AMATEUR CLASSES: Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday & competes in AOTR-AAOTR-ATR-AOTH-AAOTH class must, under USEF rules, possess a current Amateur card issued by USEF, or must have lodged with Show Secretary 1 hour prior to such class, an application for amateur certification on an application provided by USEF. An amateur non-member may participate upon payment of a \$30 non-member registration fee

ADULT WALK/TROT AATR: Rider may not enter any other performance class in this show that includes cantering.

CALL FOR CLASSES: The 2-minute rule will be STRICTLY ENFORCED. If time is needed for a tack change, the gate must be notified. All tack changes must be made at the entrance gate to the show arena. This rule will be strictly enforced!!!

CAMPERS: The Illinois State Fairgrounds regulations require that campers be self-contained and parked in a specified area and that they pay a camping fee for use of electricity. No tents allowed. Fairground Security will collect fees.

CASHING CHECKS: Personal or payback checks will not be cashed at the Show. Payback checks may be used to pay entries.

CLOSING OF ENTRIES: Entries close April 27, 2010. Entries postmarked after this date will be charged POST ENTRY FEES. This will be strictly enforced. Post entries are accepted but must be made no later than the session preceding the session the class is in. A \$5 post entry fee per class will be added. No credit will be given for swapping classes.

CONDUCT: Exhibitors are hereby notified that the AHA Board of Directors will strictly enforce and actively support all AHA, USEF and/or CEF rules regarding sportsmanship, conduct & courtesy at all AHA Recognized shows and events. This includes but is not limited to Rules that govern owners, exhibitors, agents, trainers, managers, riders, drivers, handlers, competition officials, competition employees & members of the families of the above, individual members of AHA or any person who acts in a manner in violation of the Rules or deemed prejudicial to its best interests. Any AHA and/or USEF violations committed will be subject to the AHA, USEF and/or CEF penalties.

CRUELTY TO OR THE ABUSE OF A HORSE by any person at a recognized show is forbidden. Excessive use of a whip on any horse in a stall, runway, schooling area, show ring, or elsewhere on the show grounds, before or during a show, by any person, constitutes a violation and renders the offender subject to penalty.

ENTRIES: ONE OWNER PER ENTRY BLANK ONLY! Every owner-rider-driver-handler-trainer or his/her agent(s) must sign the entry blank. IF AN OWNER-RIDER-DRIVER-HANDLER-TRAINER IS UNDER AGE 18, HIS/HER PARENT, GUARDIAN OR TRAINER MUST SIGN ENTRY BLANK ON THE MINOR'S BEHALF. IN ADDITION, THE "JUNIOR" (MINOR) EXHIBITOR CONSENT" MUST BE COMPLETED! PARENTS WHO SIGN NEED NOT BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR USEF. Entries must include full addresses, AHA, USEF & USDF membership numbers, all fees, copies of registration papers plus photo copies of 2010 AHA/USEF/USDF membership cards. The submitting of an entry blank to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth in this prize list.

PAYMENT: No entries shall be accepted without full payment. **No BLANK or POST DATED CHECKS accepted for pre-entries or stall reservations!** Entries submitted with **bad** checks will not be processed and will be returned to applicant.

HEALTH PAPERS: ALL horses must have a negative Coggins test dated within 12 months of the start of the show. Out of state horses must have a current 30-day health certificate and an Illinois Horse permit. Call 217-782-4944 or visit www.agr.state.il.us.

AHA NON-MEMBER: All non-members owning horses entered in this show must pay a single event membership fee of \$35.00 per person. Single event Members shall only have exhibiting privileges for the duration of the event where the membership is purchased. Any owner, trainer, driver, rider or handler who exhibits horses in the show ring or signs the entry form as the responsible person for any individuals horses at the show, must be a competition member of AHA or pay a single event fee of \$35.00 per person. (Exceptions: Exhibitors entered in Walk/Trot classes and Leadline shall be exempt from paying AHA non-member fees. **You MUST have an AHA Competition Level membership in order to show in the Region XI Dressage, Sport Horse and/or Hunter/Jumper Championships.**)

INDEMNITY AND NON-RESPONSIBILITY CLAUSE: ARAB Inc., Illinois Arabian Horse Association and the Illinois State Fairgrounds will not be responsible for any loss, personal injury or damage to horses exhibited or for any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed or in any way damaged.

JUMPERS: Method for determining order of go for first round will be to list horses' names and then draw for their position. Jump-off order will be established by competitors returning in original order. Classes will be judged in accordance with USEF rule JP144; see Table II, Sec. 3. Please refer to the USEF rulebook for further information.

NUMBER OF ENTRIES IN CLASS: Six (6) entries are necessary to fill a class. Any class may be cancelled, divided or combined at the discretion of the Show Managers.

PA SYSTEM: Due to possible unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the PA system & class calls over that system are considered a courtesy. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have his/her horse at the gate at the prescribed time. While every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system, no protest will be upheld nor will any section be changed on basis of a PA breakdown.

PENALTY FEES: "NO ENTRY" - Please do not show up in a class without first making the proper entry fee for that class in the show office. "NO SHOW" - To expedite flow of classes, scratches MUST be reported to the show office or the Gate BEFORE the beginning of the class. If scratches are not reported, a \$30 No Show fee and the class fee will be assessed per each unreported scratch.

REGISTRATION PAPERS: In order to credit exhibitors with their proper points toward Reg'l and Nat'l. eligibility, certification of registration from the Arabian Horse Association and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry for each horse is required with the entry form, including the backside of the form. Imported or foreign entries must have been issued a Competition Visa by the Arabian Horse Association. If under one year of age, the horse must be eligible for registry and registration applied for. FOR COMPETITION PURPOSES ANY HORSE IS CONSIDERED TO BE ONE YEAR OLD ON THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY FOLLOWING THE ACTUAL DATE OF FOALING.

REFUNDS: All fees (except office) for entries cancelled before 4/27/10 will be refunded. Refunds of class entry fees only will be made after this date upon presentation of a Vet Cert. to Show Secretary before the start of the respective show. Once a horse is vetted out of a class, it will be considered vetted out of the entire show.

SHOW OFFICE HOURS: The Show Office will be closed ½ hour before each afternoon & evening session to prepare for that session. Schedule variations will be announced.

SHOW OFFICIALS: In the event that an official fails to attend these shows or perform his/her duties, due to illness, injury or other circumstances, show committee reserves the right to substitute an official for the one designated in accordance with USEF rules.

SHOW TABS: Show tabs will not be accepted for pre-entries or stalls. Exhibitors wishing to start a tab for post entries must leave a signed check. Exhibitors understand that these checks will be completed by the Show Secretary for the amount of the tab unless exhibitor closes out the account prior to the close of the show. There will be a \$50 charge per check for checks returned by the bank. Interest of 1 ½ % per month will be assessed on all outstanding accounts. Returned checks not paid within 2 weeks after being notified will be turned over to USEF.

STALLIONS: Stallions may be shown by ladies & junior exhibitors except in Leadline and Walk-Trot classes.

FOOTING: All show and warm up areas are a sand loam mix about 4" deep. All areas are covered. The Coliseum is 60,000 square feet and the outdoor ring is 31,350 square feet.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR GR318: All riders (including junior riders) in hunter, jumper, and hunt seat equitation classes, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on competition grounds, are required to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM standards. Any rider may wear protective headgear in any division or class without penalty from the judge. USEF strongly encourages all riders to wear protective headgear. It is the responsibility of the rider, parent, guardian, or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see that the headgear worn complies with safety standards and is properly fitted and in good condition.

The Coliseum will be open for schooling horses:

- On Thursday, following the Sport Horse Under Saddle classes
- On Friday afternoon & evening before and after the awards presentation

STALLS: NO STALLS RESERVED WITHOUT PAYMENT. Stalls are mandatory for all horses, weaning or older. All 10' x 10' stalls have doors and are under cover. Aisles are to be kept clear at all times and are not to be blocked with stall curtains. No charges in stabling permitted without Barn Manager's permission. NO STRAW ALLOWED AT THE SHOW! Shavings available for purchase or bring your own. No nails, staples, or tape in new stalls. Hay & grain available on grounds at market price.

STALL AVAILABILITY

- Stalls available at 8 AM on Tuesday, June 1. All horses & equipment must be removed from the fairgrounds by noon Monday, June 7. There is a \$10 charge per day for early arrival and late departure.
- Fairgrounds Security requests that animals not arrive between midnight and 8 AM. Prior approval must be received from the Fairgrounds for early arrival and late departure. For information or approval, contact the Business Services Bureau or Fairgrounds Security at 217-782-2622.

GOLF CARTS: Personal golf carts will cost \$10 per day. Golf cart rental is available at \$35 per day. Contact Lori Prose in the Business Services Bureau, 217-782-0875.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE OPERATION: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

FARRIER: No farrier other than the official farrier(s) will be permitted to shoe on the grounds without the express permission of Show Management. Farriers granted this permission will be required to purchase Commercial Exhibitor space and provide proof of insurance. Official show farrier(s), the USEF Steward (s) and the judge are the final authorities on shoe and hoof measurements.

2010 AHA MEDAL CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

AHA Hunter Seat Over Obstacles Medal class

- 1) To be shown over a course of not fewer than six obstacles with fence heights of 2'6" to 3' which must include an oxer and two changes of direction (changes of lead). (Res. 53-96)
- 2) Two or more tests of the top four contestants are required from USEF Tests 1 -7, 9-15, 17-19 or EC equivalent. Only one rider per horse.

AHA Saddle Seat Medal Class

- 1) In addition to the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USEF Tests 1-15 or EC equivalent. Markers shall not be used.

AHA Reining Seat Medal Class

- 1) All contestants are required to perform a Reining pattern as outlined in USEF Reining, or EC equivalent. (Res 25-06)
- 2) Dropping of bits is optional with the judge but if called for in the ring, assistance, if necessary, may be had from one of the ring officials.
- 3) Reins shall not be removed from the horse's neck while inspecting bits.
- 4) In an AHA Reining Seat Medal class an off pattern rider is eliminated and is not eligible to win a medal or ribbon.
- 5) The prescribed AHA Reining Seat Equitation Score Sheet must be used and posted in accordance with USEF rule AR199.5. (Res.25-06)
- 6) For Exhibitor Number information, refer to USEF rule EQ103.6. (Res. 8/07)

AHA Hunter Seat Not to Jump Medal Class

- 1) In addition to the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USEF AR217 1-4 & sub chapter 2 (EQ113).

AHA Western Horsemanship Medal class

- 1) In addition to the rail work, all contestants are required to perform a minimum of four tests from USEF AR224. (BOD 5/06)

Arabian & HA/AA Lead Line, Rider 2 to 6 Years

Horses to be led by an adult on a loose line at a walk on the rail both ways of the ring. Riders & leaders should show in suitable, appropriate attire in keeping with the type of equipment used on the horse. To be judged on child's seat & rein. Riders may not show in any other performance class except Walk-Trot.

Select AOTR - See USEF AR. 113.f - classes open to rider/driver/handler that has not won any of the following:

- AHA Regional Top 5 or better in the corresponding class or any open class in the respective section
- AHA National Top 10 or better in the corresponding class or any open class in the respective section.
- Two AHA Regional Top 5 award or higher in a corresponding Limited class.
- An AHA National Top 10 or higher award in a corresponding Limited class.
- Riders of Arabian, Half-Arabian or Anglo Arabian horses competing in the same section shall not be considered separately.
- If a rider is eligible to compete as a limited rider in a respective section on December 1, said eligibility remains throughout the competition year (that eligibility is determined beginning with Regional and National shows of 1997).

SWEEPSTAKES POINT PROGRAM: This program is optional for horses when all sweepstakes requirements are met. Sweepstakes nominated horses must be enrolled in the sweepstakes point program to be eligible for prize money payout for accumulated points. Enrollments must be dated to the AHA Office before the first day of the show. Show secretaries may not accept sweepstakes point program enrollments. Annual enrollment fee is \$100. For those classes eligible to be split into multiple age divisions, points will be earned in each split class. Only horses participating in AHA recognized local shows and events will receive points up to sixth place.

If fewer than nine horses are in the class, 50% rounded up will be eligible for points.

For horses participating in Regional shows, points up to five places will be earned.

A dollar sign (\$) will appear for each designated class.

Any horse may compete in ABS designated classes.

SHOEING REGULATIONS:

1. Horses less than two years of age must be shown barefoot. Horses two years of age may be shown with a shoe in accordance with AR103.2. However, the use of a pad(s) of any type or configuration between hoof and shoe is strictly prohibited.
2. Through November 30, 2008, any machine made (keg) or handmade shoe made of magnetic steel, mild steel, or aluminum is allowable. No part of the shoe may exceed the dimensions of 3/8 inch thick by 1 1/8 inches wide (nail heads and/or toe clips are not considered when measuring the shoe). The shoe may be of any type and configuration except in the case of a bar shoe, the bar may not extend below the ground surface of the shoe. If a shoe band is used, it **may** be attached to the shoe, or the pad, if present.
3. Maximum length of toe is 4 1/2" for purebred Arabians. Maximum length of toe is 5" for Half-Arabians and Anglo-Arabians.
4. The use of pad(s) (either full or partial, including rim) made of leather or plastic, is allowed as long as the overall length of toe measurement (See GR510) does not exceed the maximum toe length of 4 1/2" for purebred Arabians or 5" for Half-Arabians and Anglo-Arabians. The introduction of a foreign material within the pad, between the pad and shoe or between the pad and hoof (other than accepted packing material such as oakum, pine tar, silicone, foam rubber, etc.) designed to add additional weight or enhance action is strictly prohibited. Material with anticoncussive qualities (such as rubber, silicone, latex, etc.) may be used between the pad and hoof for additional support, provided such material does not extend beyond the inner rim (edge) of the shoe.
5. At the discretion of a judge or a steward officiating at a licensed Arabian competition, or at the request of the Show Committee (See GR1201) inspection (including measuring the shoe, measurement of hoof length, and presence of a pad) of shoes, pad(s) and/or hoof length may be required. Shoes and pads, if present, cast after entering or before exiting the arena in any class shall be inspected. Said inspection shall be performed by a licensed steward or judge designated by the Show Committee (The Show Committee may at its discretion designate more than one licensed official to perform inspections). Any trainer, exhibitor and/or agent of a horse subject to the inspection each may request to be present and heard while said inspection is being performed by said licensed official(s). Prior to any disqualification and/or other penalties imposed on a horse at a competition, the inspecting officials shall make reasonable efforts to notify and have present the owner(s) and trainer(s) of said horse, or agent(s) at the inspection. The inspecting officials shall take possession of any shoe, and/or pad and measure the shoe with an accurate gauge. Measurement of hoof length shall be made in accordance with GR510. In the event that the inspecting officials find a violation of the shoe measurements, hoof length and/or pad presence the horse shall be disqualified for the entire competition, and the owner shall be required to forfeit all prize money, sweepstakes and trophies, entry fees, ribbons, and points won at said competition by said horse. Additionally, if any forbidden foreign material is found between the pad and/or shoe, or pad and hoof, within the pad, and/or the pad composition is in violation of AR103.1, the steward shall file a charge against the owner(s) and trainer(s) with the Federation Hearing Committee in accordance with GR604 and a hearing shall be held in accordance with General Rules, Chapter GR6. The trainer of a horse found to be shod with any forbidden material as described, is subject to whatever additional penalty or penalties are assessed by the Hearing Committee following a hearing. Said trainer may be fined and/or suspended from all competitions for a period of up to one year for the first offense, said suspension to be served at any time at the discretion of the Hearing Committee. The horse may be suspended for any period of time specified by the Hearing Committee.
6. All horses competing in the Arabian, Half-Arabian, and Anglo-Arabian Hunter, Jumper, Dressage, Eventing, Combined Driving, Pleasure (Carriage) Driving, Working Western, and Sport Horse Sections shall be exempt from shoeing regulations. This does not exempt horses that are cross entered into any other classes from compliance with applicable shoeing requirements while competing in those classes.
